**In summer 2019 we are forming a Joint contingent with Slovakian Scouts to share scouting experiences and learn about each other's lives and the cultures and most importantly to have a good time together. To make this happen the Joint Contingent will be attending the Haarlem Jamborette. There we will be doing lots of activities, cooking and camping alongside our new friends from Slovakia.**

### What is a Jamborette?

You guessed right, it's a small Jamboree. Not that small though there will be 3,500 Scouts and Guides attending from all around the world.

### Where is Haarlem?

Haarlem is a city in the Netherlands. It is the capital of the province of North Holland and is just a 15 minute train ride from Amsterdam. The Jamborette is held in a nature reserve located between Amsterdam, Haarlem and Velsen. This reserve has many hiking routes, a mountain bike track, swimming lakes and even a ski slope and a climbing wall. In addition, big events are held in the reserve every year, and in 2019 the Jamborette will be one of them.



### When is the Haarlem Jamborette?

The Haarlem Jamborette starts on 28th July and finishes on 7 August. We will be looking to extend the fun with a 3 day pre Jamboree programme including a visit to Amsterdam and exploring the Haarlem area.

### Who can go?

If you are will be an Explorer Scout or Young Leader under 18 on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2019 you can apply to join this trip.

### How are meals arranged ?

At the Jamborette all the food is provided along with recipes and we cook it ourselves. The following special diets are provided for: vegetarian, no pork, lactose intolerance, gluten intolerance, nut intolerance and diabetes.

### What will it cost?

The cost of the trip is heavily dependent on the value of the Euro as three quarters of the spending will be on items priced in Euros. We also need to fix our pre or post jamboree programme before we can know the cost. So we are setting a maximum amount and we'll try to bring the cost down as things get more certain. The cost for the trip will not be more than £800. This will cover:

- 10 days Jamboree
- 3 days pre jamboree activities
- Transport to and from the Jamboree
- All meals
- Scout Insurance
- 3 Weekend training events
- Contingent polo shirt and neckerchief
